



Assistant/Associate Professor in Health Services Aging Research

University of Connecticut School of Medicine

The UConn Center on Aging at the University of Connecticut School of Medicine is recruiting a full-time Assistant or Associate Professor to conduct research and teach in the area of health services and aging. The individual filling this position is expected to lead research and evaluation studies developed in collaboration with state and/or federal agency and community partners, specifically in long-term services and supports (LTSS) for older adults and people with disabilities.

The ideal candidate will have a PhD in health services research or policy, gerontology, public health, or relevant social sciences field with federal, state and/or other grant or contract funding experience, a publication record in respected academic journals, and commitment to advancing health equity and impacting public and population health. Candidates with knowledge and interests in aging and disability, strong written and oral communication skills, experience with statistical software, data analysis and management of Medicare or Medicaid claims data, and evidence of successful collaboration with state and/or federal agencies are especially encouraged to apply.

Located on the UConn Health campus in Farmington CT, midway between Boston and New York, UConn Center on Aging is the multidisciplinary home to investigators in social, behavioral, clinical, biological, and population sciences. UConn Center on Aging faculty maintain extensive associations with national, state and local health and social services agencies and across UConn, ranked one of the of the top public universities in the nation. The successful candidate will commit to collaborating with Center on Aging faculty on existing LTSS research and evaluation grants and forming new collaborations with state or federal agencies, community-based organizations, and faculty across UConn. This position is fully funded through existing grants and State evaluation contracts through March, 2024. Ongoing application for extramural research funding is expected subsequently. The candidate will have teaching and advising responsibilities with MPH, PhD, medical/dental students, medical residents and fellows. This is a 12-24 month renewable full year salary in-residence faculty position.
